The applicant (f/m) hired into this position will be expected to contribute to the regular teaching duties of the Institute, in particular courses of the secondary school teacher accreditation programme in Mathematics (training of future high school teachers), including Didactics of Mathematics, and the master programme (joint with the Technical University of Graz) Mathematical Computer Sciences. In addition, competence in Gender Mainstreaming is expected.

The University of Graz is committed to increasing the number of women in leadership positions. In case of equal qualifications, precedence will be given to female applicants.
